# PASS THE MANTIE...CARRY ON

In late June 2021 James (Butch) Mathews and the Riverside Neighborhood Reunion Committee met on these very grounds to discuss the possibility of this event. His dream of bringing this family type reunion to fruition was overwhelming. He wanted the community to feel the love and connectedness he had experience growing up here. He wanted neighbors to get to know each other, make new friendships, talk with one another, and see each other as family... a modern day neighborhood reunion.

"We are getting older, who's going to pick up this mantle. We need to hand this off to the younger generation. If we don't do it now, then when! We may not be here next year. Let's show them how. Let's pass the mantle, so they can carry on!!"

### **Blinky Allen**

Bryant Wesley "Blinky" Allen was born in Riverside California on January 14,1919. After returning from WWII Bryant formed his own groups-The Starliters and the Blinky Allen Group. Allen earned the nickname of "Blinky" because he used to blink his eyes when he played the drums. Another honoree, Reggie Strickland, also a native of Riverside, was also member of his band. Bryant always stipulated that there was to be no discrimination against Blacks in the clubs in which he performed. Blinky died in Los Angeles in 1969.





### Reginald & Susan Strickland

Reginald "Reggie" Errol Strickland was a talented tenor saxophonist, with a true appreciation for music. He loved music

so much that he and his beloved wife, Sue, shared his love of music, and her love of teaching with their children, as well as with the children in their Riverside neighborhood. Both Reggie and Sue were active members of the Riverside NAACP. They were very supportive of ACT-SO (Afro-Academic, Cultural Technological Olympics) a program of the NAACP intended to promote academic and cultural achievement in high school students.

This year's Reunion Donation to ACT-SO is in honor of the late Reggie Strickland and his wife Susan.

### **Charles Bibbs**

### **CHARLES A. BIBBS and STUDIO B ART PUBLISHING**

Charles Bibbs is an internationally recognized artist, entrepreneur, and philanthropist noted for his beautiful artistic renderings that convey deep senses of spirituality, majesty, dignity, strength, and grace. He attended Los Angeles Harbor College, Long Beach City College, and Cal State Dominguez Hills, where he studied studio arts and fine art printing.

Charles Bibbs' work displays a unique, robust, and stylized quality done in a combination of abstract and realistic interpretations of contemporary subjects that are fused into

beautiful, multifaceted ethnicity, larger-than-life images. His technique and style are distinguished from most artists by how he combines layers of acrylic paints and inks to obtain rich undertones of line textures.

During his 47 years as an artist, Bibbs has received over 100 recognition and awards for his art and philanthropic spirit, including the "Key to the City" awards in 7 major cities across the United States. His work has been featured on many commemorative posters across the United States and in major films, such as the "The Secret Life of Bees (he created the "Black Madonna" image for this movie)," television, notable books and CD covers including cover designs for the Urban Knight Collection; featuring legendary musicians Ramsey Lewis and Grover Washington, Jr. One of Bibbs career highlights was his collaboration with Nelson Mandela on art drawings created by Mandela during his imprisonment.

Bibbs' work has been displayed in numerous solo and group exhibitions throughout the country and abroad and has been collected worldwide.

### **Maurice Howard**

Maurice Howard was born in Waco, Texas. When he was three years old, his family moved to France, where his dad served in the military. When they returned to the United States they moved to Riverside California.

At the age of 19, Howard became inspired to paint. He attended several independent art schools, and later enrolled into Cal State Fullerton College, where he majored in fine art studies. After completing college, he was hired by Hanna-Barbera Production Studio, as an In-Betweener in the animation department.



Following his employment at Hanna-Barbera, he worked as a Dental Technician in Pasadena, California. Inspired by Salvador Dali, M.C. Escher, and African-American graphic artist and painter Charles White, Howard's style of work can be viewed across the board, from realism to surrealism. Using a mixture of pencil, acrylic, and oil, he creates rich images and stunning abstracts that are exceptionally unique, such that, once you view them for a period of time, a mysterious image is revealed under his continuous layers of lines and curves.

Today, Maurice credits much of his success to renowned artist Charles Bibbs, who has supported and motivated him. "I am extremely grateful to have this opportunity to work under an artist of his caliber and one who is highly respected in the art community." Maurice serves as a member of the Art 2000 Visual Artists Association, founded by Charles Bibbs to help support young and emerging artists.

Ruben Guitron is Pastor of the Riverside Faith Temple Ministries located 2343 Pennsylvania Ave, Riverside, CA 92507.






